



Contours are approximate.
A relative height, e.g., 100, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Cart-tracks and unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally metalled in dry season. Permission to use these along canals is required from Irrigation authorities.
Wells and tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
Tanks shown dry in this area, usually contain water from July to March.
Forts on the Gomati River only take pedestrian traffic.
A relative height, e.g., 10, marked along a canal indicates the height of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
This sheet has been compiled from 1:25,000 survey.
