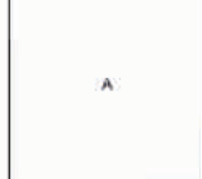

In Marathi names the letter d has frequently the sound of v; invariably the sound of t and v invariably of w, when an initial letter, and of w when otherwise placed.
The state boundary between Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra States has been surveyed as pointed out by the local officials on the ground, but has not been verified by the Governments concerned.
