### REHABILITATION AND RESETTLEMENT PLAN

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The Gondulpara coal block is located in North-Eastern part of North Karanpura Coalfields and falls within the administrative jurisdiction of Hazaribagh district of Jharkhand State. The North Karanpura Coalfield is the western most coalfield of Damodar Valley Coal basins. Administratively, the coalfield falls in the districts of Hazaribagh, Chatra, Latehar & Ranchi of Jharkhand State. The coalfield is elliptical in shape having axes of 64 Km in east-west direction and 32 Km in north-south direction and hence this forms a prominent east-west trending valley between Hazaribagh plateau in the north and Ranchi plateau in the south. The Block is allotted to Adani Enterprises Ltd. (AEL), through the commercial coal mining auction process vide Letter No. NA-104/10/2020-NA dated 08.03.2021 by MoC, GoI.

#### 2. DEMOGRAPHY

The main village within the block is Gundalpara, situated along Badmahi river in North Western part of the block. Another small village Gali is also situated in the eastern part of the block. The adjoining villages are Phulang situated at western boundary & Hahe on the other side of Badmahi river in Northern side. Balodar village is located in the North Eastern side of the block. The population details of prominent villages lying within the mine lease area is given in **Table-1**

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The total population of Gondalpura, Gali, Balodar, Hahe and Phulang is 2354, 317, 957, 394 and 7 respectively as per 2011 census. These villages comprise mainly of Hindus, Muslims, Tribals and few Christians. The exact data regarding the population of all the project affected people and project affected families for the calculation of compensation regarding R&R plan will be obtained only after detailed SES/SIA study.

### A) Compensation for Land Owners

Availability of land is key for any green field project. For mining projects land can be treated as raw material.

In Jharkhand State land is categorized in following types,

- 1. Tenancy Land
- 2. Forest land (It also includes Revenue Forest)
- 3. Government Land

Process of acquiring above mentioned types is different and governed by separate legislations & regulations of Central Government & State Government which is presented below:

- Tenancy Land This type of land belongs to private landowners (Farmers/Homesteads) and is being acquired through:
  - ☐ The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013
- 2. Forest Land This type of land is not acquired; it is diverted enabling user agency to use forest land for non-forestry purpose. Diversion of forest land is done under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and relevant regulations / circulars issued by Ministry of Environment & Forest GOI & Government of Jharkhand.

Entitlements mentioned in The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement (RFCT/LARR) Act, 2013 and Jharkhand RFCT/LARR rules 2015. Land compensation calculation as per Schedule-I is presented in **Table 2**


