

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC(pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purpose read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 1.569 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of CMRL, Chennai for CMRL Phase – II C5-06 Madhavaram to Sholinganallur – Nanmangalam forest land required for Elevated Metro Station of Chengalpattu district falls within jurisdiction of Tambaram Taluk, Chengalpattu District.

It is certified that:

- a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 1.569 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the forest rights committee(s), Gramasabha(s), sub division level committee(s) and district level committees are enclosed as annexure – I to III.
- b) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the gramasabhas have given their consent to it.
- c) The proposal to involve recognized rights of primitive tribal groups and pre agricultural communities.

"It is further certified that the proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Group and Pre-Agricultural communities".
