In Compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests Government of India's Letter No.11-9-98-FC Dated 3rd August 2009 where in the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the schedule Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of forest Rights Act 2006 (FRA For Short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for Non- forest purpose read with MOEF letter dated 5th February 2013 where in MOEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects. It is certified that 0.133 hectares (Length 414.2 Meter, Width 3.2 Meter) of forest land proposed to be diverted in favor of Block Development Officers Pallipet Taluk, Tiruvallur District for Construction of road in exiting right of way which leads to Cherlopalli Road in Tiruvallur District, within jurisdiction Athimanjeripet Village, Kodivalasa Panchayath Pallipet Taluk.

It is further certified that:

- (I) The complete Process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 0.133 hectares (Length 414.2 Meter, Width 3.2 Meter) of forest area proposed for diversion A copy of records of all Consolation and meetings of the GRAMA SABA is enclosed as annexure
- (II) Certified that there No Schedule tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers in Konasamudram RF of Pallipet Taluk, Tiruvallur District and Consequently no claims have been received under this Act with respect to the area Proposed for construction of road in the exiting right of way.
- (III) Certified that there no primitive Tribal Groups (PTG) and pre Agricultural communities (PAC) in the Cherlopalli Road Konasamudram R.F. of Pallipet Taluk, Tiruvallur District. So the recognized rights of PTG and PAC are not affected.
