**Copy note containing details of the plan for transportation of the minerals proposed to be raised from the mining lease**

The mineral marble will be mined out as blocks and will be supplied to various gang saw units for further processing in to slabs and tiles situated at Udaipur , Rajsamand , Kishangarh and Chittorgarh

The blocks will be transported by surface transportation mode from source to destination.

Transportation will initiate from mine to pucca village approach road which will connect to Chittorgarh Dahod NH 56 via Pipalkhunth Mahi dam road & further it will be diverted to Banswara Udaipur mega highway & connect to NH 8 for Udaipur / Rajsamand / Kishangarh destinations.

While for Chittorgarh it will go via Pratapgarh- Nimbahera at NH 56 to the destination

Approximate distance from mine site to different destinations will be as under

- Kela Mela to Udaipur – 172 Kms.
- Kela Mela to Chittorgarh – 162 Kms
- Kela Mela to Rajsamand – 233 Kms
- Kela Mela to Kishangarh – 464 Kms

While the irregular mined out pieces and waste will be supplied to various construction and cement industries at Nimbahera , Chittorgarh or Udaipur through the same routes shown above.
