Justification for Locating the Project in Forest Land

Public Works department, Koppal Division, Government of Karnataka has decided to take up Improvements to Road from Kabbaragi village to Kapilateertha in Kushtagi Taluka, Koppal District in the state of Karnataka. The project area is situated in Kabbaragi village of Kushtagi Taluk, Koppal Districtin the State of Karnataka.

Kapilateertha is fall situated near the kabbaragi village, which also a famous tourist destination in the monsoon season for the people of Koppal, Bagalkot and Gadag districts etc. When the monsoon approaches due to Non availability of the proper approach road its very difficult to reach the destination for the tourists/People and also it prevents the people from making there own footways in the Forest Land. So it is very much essential for the drought prone area of Kushtagi Taluka, Koppal District to construct the road of Width 6 Mtrs (5.5 M (Carriage Way)+0.25M (Murrum Shoulders Both sides)).

The length of the road passing through the forest land is about 1.6 Km which acquires the area of about 0.96 Ha, Where as Non-Forest Land is about 0.04 Ha.

As it is a need since long time from the public and the elected representatives to provide a approach road which very feasible in socio-economic point of view.
