I am directed to refer to your letter No. TECML/MoC/MP/2008/23 dated 03.10.2008 submitting mining plan October, 2006) for Gondulpara coal block in the North Karanpura coalfield, Dist. Hazaribagh, Jharkhand submitted by M/s. Tenughat Emta Coal Mines Ltd. has been considered and the approval of the Central Government thereon is hereby conveyed under Section 5 (2) (b) of the Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957 subject to the following condition:

- The mining company shall take all necessary precautions regarding safety of mine workings, persons deployed therein.
- ii) Mining lease to be acquired shall not encroach into any other coal block.
- iii) Before placing any overburden dump out side the allotted block boundary, the mining company shall ensure, by additional exploration, that the dump site is non coal bearing and also that the area is not a part of any other coal block.



- iv) The approval of the mining plan is without prejudice to the requirement of approvals from competent/prescribed authority under the relevant rules/regulations etc.
- v) The mining company to extract the coal blocked in batter & barriers along the common boundary between the adjacent blocks.
- vi) The mining company to explore the possibility of diversion of Brahmi river to avoid sterilization of about 21 Mt. of coal.
