
Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
A metric height, e.g., 20, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
The kilometre along numbers along the railway are shown in short type, e.g., '5'.
Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks along canal embankments are usually metalled. Permission to use these is required from the irrigation authorities. Other unmetalled roads in this sheet are indicated in dry season.
A metric height, e.g., 20, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to January.
