




CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

NOTES

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
A relative height, e.g., 50, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
The kilometre stone numbers along roads and canals are shown in short type, e.g., 1/5 whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., 5.
Wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
Cart tracks and unmetalled roads along canals are not shown in dry season. Permission to use these is required from the irrigation authorities.
Tanks, shown dry in the sheet, usually contain water from July to March.
A relative height, e.g., 50, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
The sheet has been compiled from a 1:25,000 survey.
