NOTES

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
A relative height, e.g., represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
The kilometre stone numbers along the railway and roads are shown in slant type, e.g., 5, whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., 5.
Unmetalled roads and cart-track in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use these roads along canals is required from the irrigation authorities.
Wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
Tanks shown, dry, in this area, usually contain water from July to March.
A relative height, e.g., marked along a canal indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
