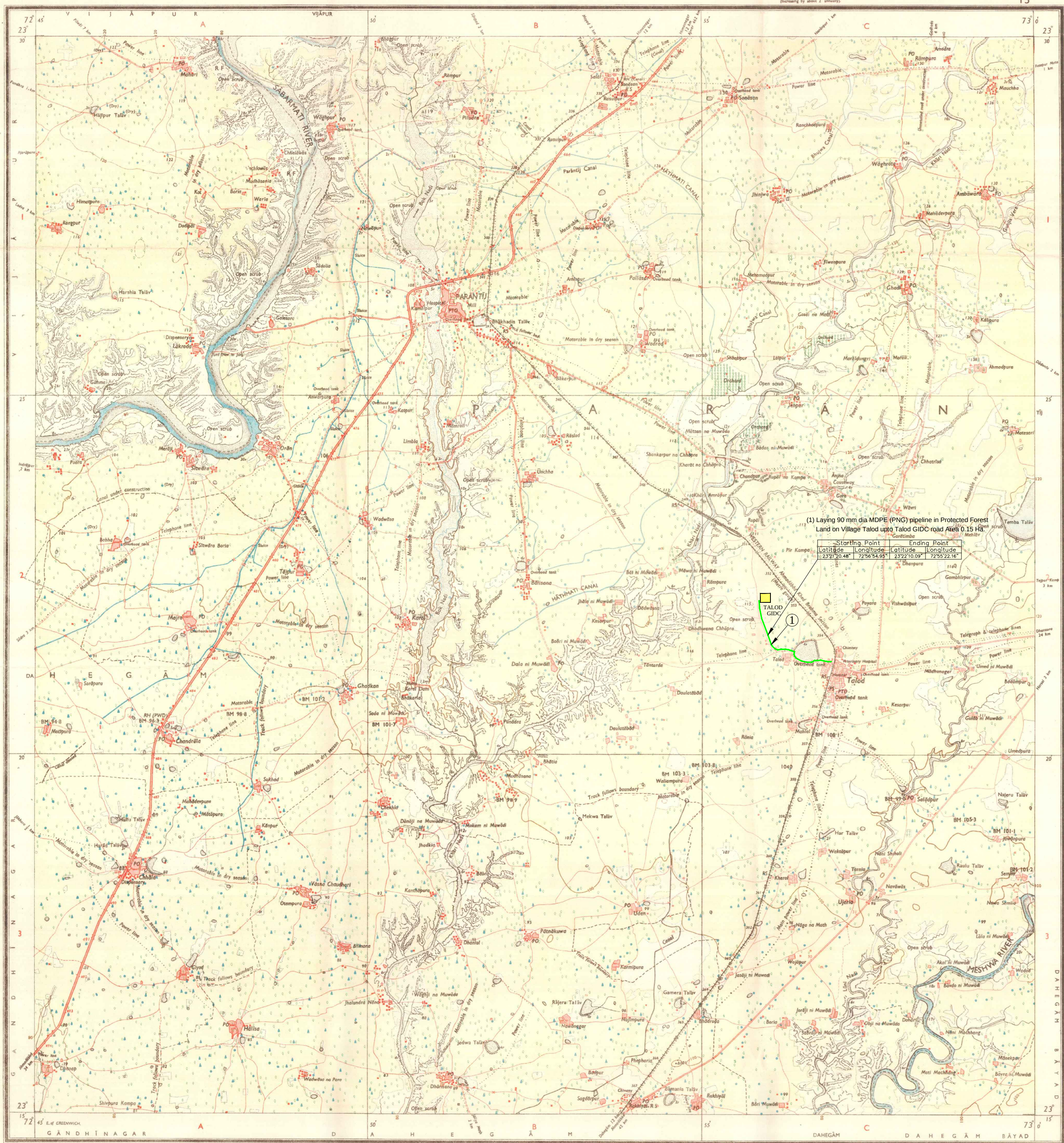

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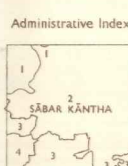

Tanks shown dry in this area usually contain water from July to October.
Canal hedges generally exist along canals and field bunds.
Portions of district boundary between Ahmedabad and Sabar Kanta Districts in square B/3 have been shown from the reconnaissance survey carried out during 1949-50.
Unmetalled road along canal embankment is motorable. Permission to use this road is required from the brigadier authorities.

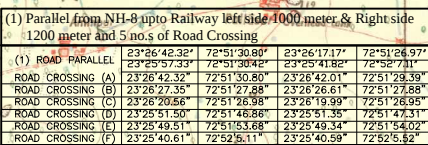
