Point No: 01

This type of Mineral of Black Granite is available only in Forest land and it is unique one and not available other than Forest Area.

Point No: 02

The present subject area lies at a distance of 2456 mts to Pulimaduguvuru Village of Bangarupalyam Mandal, situated in C.No.205 of Ragimanupenta Reserve Forest as crow fly distance which is nearer to the Location.

Point No: 03 (Details of other mining leases)

There is no existing lease in the said subject area.

Point No: 04 (Renewals)

Does not arise since it is a fresh proposal.

Point No: 05 (Waste Management)

With regard to waste management outside the mine in Non-forest land, the material available in the present applied area is vein type deposit. Hence, it is necessary to win the material in the form of open-cast mining method. The waste management plan will be shown in the mining plan.

Cluster E.C and other issues will be pursued by the user agency.

Plan No.07.

No National Park/ Wild life sanctuary/Tiger Reserve Forest/Bio-sphere reserve/Elephant Corridor etc/ Archaeological Importance.

Plan No.08;

Black Granite is a Minor Mineral which is regulated by the Andhra Pradesh Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1966 and the provisions laid down under the Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Amendment Act, 2015 are applicable.

In view of the above circumstances, I furnish herewith the statutory proformas in (7) sets along with technical report and requested the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Aranyabhavan, Guntur, to process and accord clearance for diversion of forest land for non-forest purpose for grant of Black Granite over an extent of 4.900 Hects. in Compt. No. 205 of Ragimanupenta Reserve Forest Village, Bangarupalyam Mandal, Chittoor West Division, Chittoor District filed by M/s Prathima Granites, Prop: Sri K. Dheeraj.
