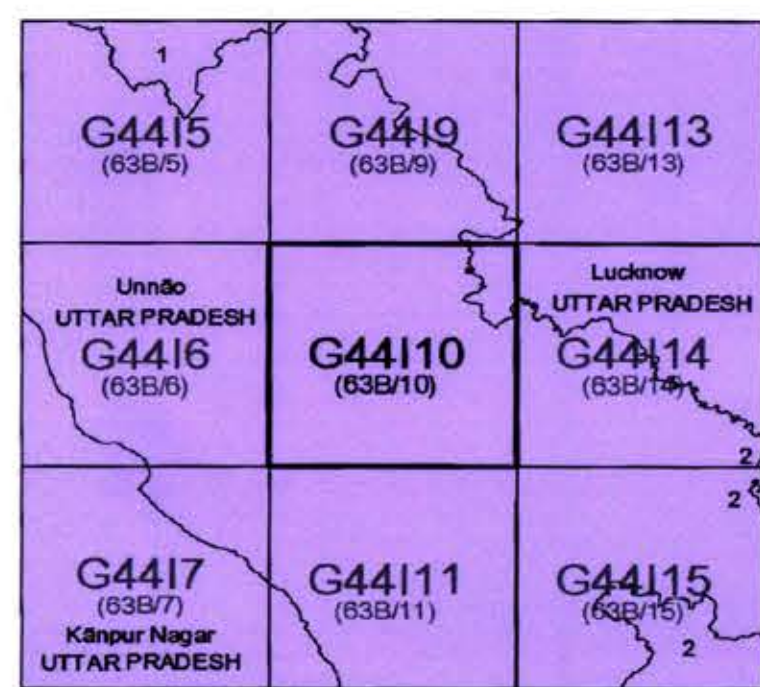

NOTES

- Cart tracks and unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use these roads is subject to the permission of the local authorities.
- Wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown
- Tanks, shown dry in this area, usually contain water from July to March
- A relative height, e.g., demarcated along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country

- Areas unfit for cultivation due to layers of caustic soda are shown as 'Waste land'
