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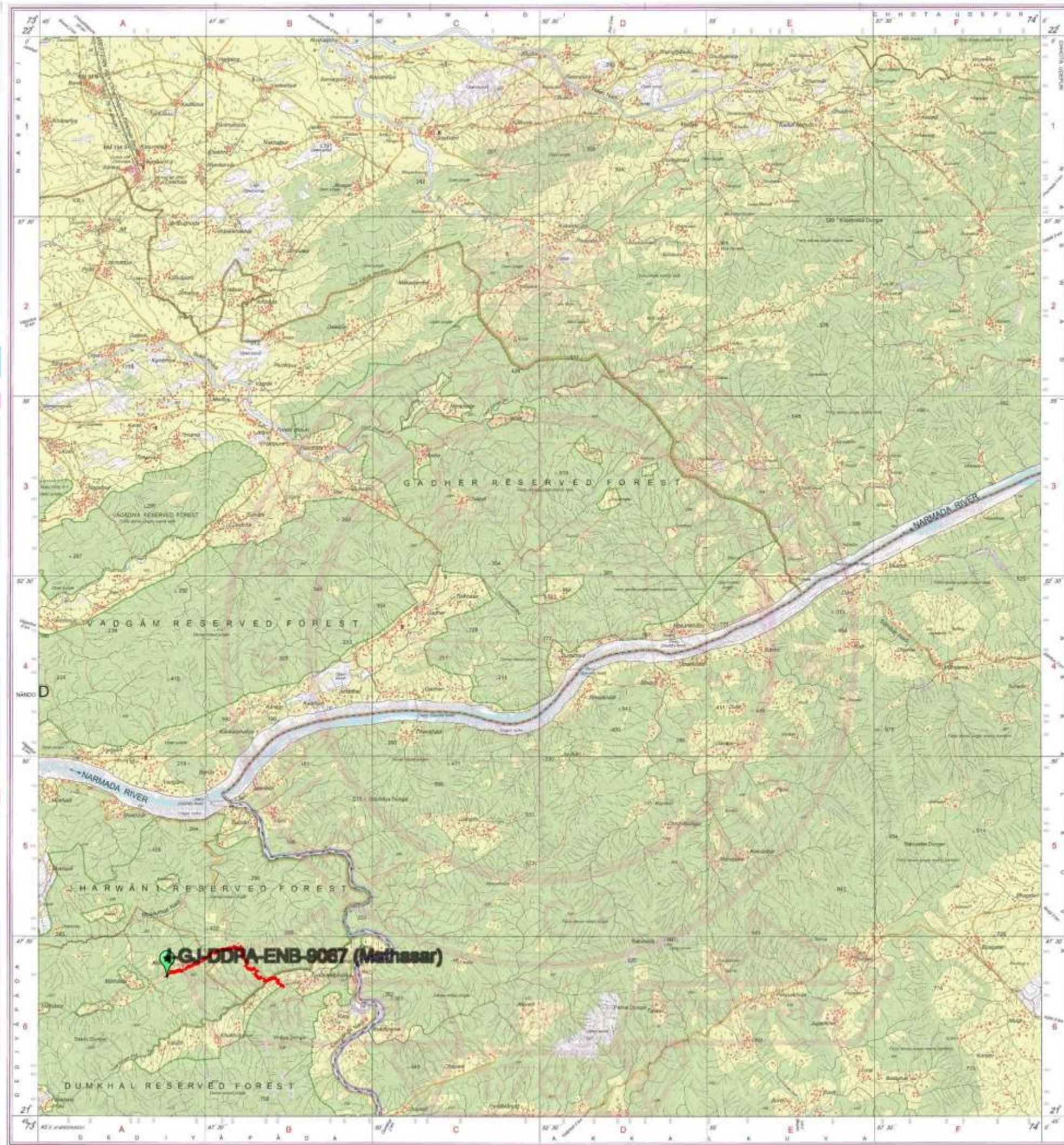

Height is a continuous variable and takes many values.
Continuous variables are measured.
A relative height, h , represents the approximate height, in metres, of a person. Consider the following data set of a group of people.

The following stem-and-leaf plot using the height data shows the distribution. A stem of 20 represents a relative height of 20 metres (2000 cm). The leaves are the digits 0–9.

Stem-and-leaf plot using the height data. The stems are the relative heights in metres, against which the leaves are the individual heights. The leaves are generally ordered in increasing order.

The data frequency is shown. The number of leaves for each stem is the number of people in the group with that relative height. The total number of leaves is the number of people in the group, which is 100.

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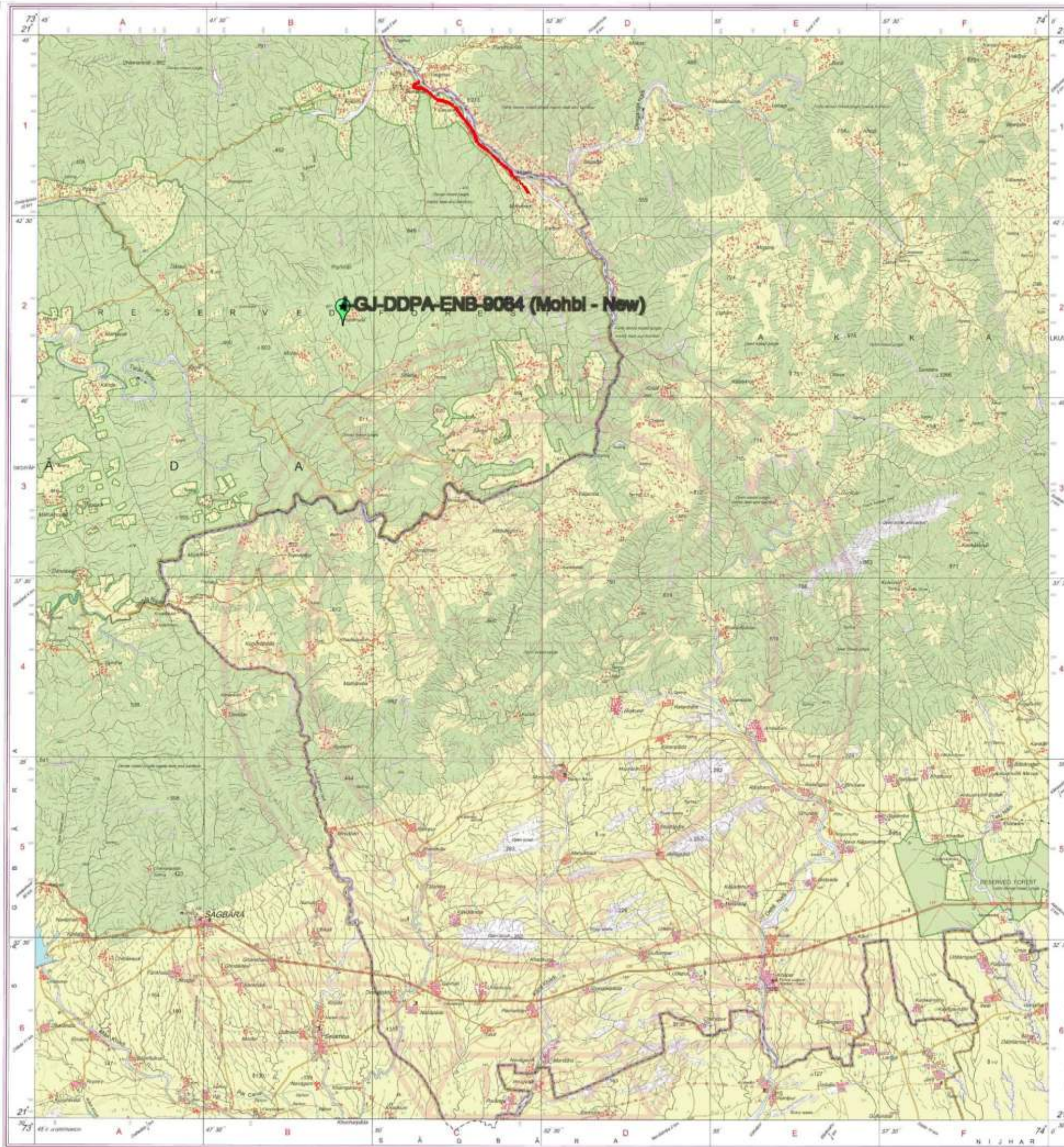
