NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and show Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.

A relative height, e.g., 80, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

The kilometre stone numbers along roads, railways and canals are shown in start type, e.g., '1' where milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., '15'.

Wells and tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.

A relative height, e.g., 80, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.

Cart-tracks and unmetalled roads in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use those along and inside forest is required from the Irrigation and Forest authorities, respectively.

Common boundaries of India and China, usually contain water from July to January.

Common boundaries of Reserved Forests have not been shown for want of reliable information.
