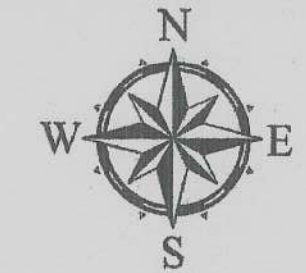


TOPOGRAPHICAL MAP SHOWING NON-FOREST LAND PROPOSED FOR COMPENSATORY AFFORESTATION

The East Coast Railway Line has been assumed from aerial imagery 1957-58 of 1967 & 2005 but its distance shown here not been shown due to lack of information.
