

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (Pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF&CC issued guidelines on the submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlements of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 (FRA, for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 9.020 hectare of revenue forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of M/s. Birla Corporation Limited, Bikram Coal Block, Shahdol for diversion of forest land for underground and opencast mine of coal in Shahdol district falls within jurisdiction of Gopalpur & Bartara village(s) in Burhar tehsils.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 9.020 hectare (Bartara 5.506 hectare & Gopalpur 3.514 hectare) of revenue forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure A1 to A2 annexure B : and annexure C .
- (b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular / local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest-dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA;
- (c) The each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the gram sabha of Gopalpur & Bartara village(s) is enclosed as annexure A1 to annexure A2 .
- (d) The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present;
- (e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it;
- (f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agriculture Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1)(e) of the FRA.
