

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MOEF), Government of India's letter No .11-9/98-FC(pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non - forest purposes read with MOEF's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2013 wherein MOEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 6.5976 hectare of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of *National Highway Authority of India PIU Barmer* in Barmer district falls within jurisdiction of Agoriya and Nimbala villages in Shiv Tehsil

It is further certified that:-

- (a) The complete process of identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 6.5976 hectares of forest area ( roadside plantation area) proposed for diversion. A Copy of records of all consultations and meeting of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure A to annexure C
- (b) The Diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram sabhas have given their consent to it.
- (c) The proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural communities.
