

NOTES

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.

Contours are approximate.

A relative height, e.g., 50, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

Wells and tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.

The kilometre stone numbers along roads, railways and canals are shown in short type, e.g., 2, whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., 50.

Unmetalled roads and cart tracks, in this sheet, are generally metalled in dry season. Permission to use these along canals is issued from the Irrigation authorities.

The triangulated heights and contours in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the spirit-levelled bench-marks and may not be strictly in accordance with them.

Trees, shown only in this area, usually denote water from July to December.

A relative height, e.g., 50, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
