In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-09/98-FC(pt) dated 28th October 2014 it is certified that 35.71435 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Executive Engineer P.D., P.W.D., Orai (name of user agency) for Construction of Four Lane Jalaun to Orai (Bilrayan – Panwari Road SH-21 From Km. 352.000 to 370.450, Bypass No. 1 & 2 and Remaining Part of NH-25 District-Jalaun, (purpose for diversion of forest land) in Jalaun District falls within jurisdiction of Gram Sabha- Bhitara (Revenue Village), Kukargaon (Revenue Village) in Jalaun Tehsil & Bohadpura, Rahiya, Rageda, Ragauli (Revenue Village) in Orai Tehsil.

According to notification no. 1115/XIV-331-50 February 10, 1960 the land was diverted as protected forest in 1960 which is less than 75 years. Hence there is no need to call open meeting of gram sabha.

It is further certified that the forest land proposed to be diverted is plantation which was notified as “forest” less than 75 years prior to the 13th day of December 2005 and is located in village having no recorded population of Schduled Tribes, as per the Census-2001 and census-2011.
