Sir,

This has reference to your letters No.Camp-BBSR-01 dated 1.1.2007 and 12.02.2007 on the above mentioned subject.

2. The above referred proposal was considered by the Expert Appraisal Committee for River Valley & Hydroelectric projects in its meeting held on 17.1.2007 and reconsidered on 21st February, 2007. This is a run of the river project across river Kolab at Village Tentuligumma in Koraput District of Orissa State. The total land requirement for the project is 6.122 ha. out of this 4.902 ha. is forest land. Forest clearance is yet to be obtained. There are no archaeological sites/monuments as well as wildlife sanctuaries/national parks within 10 km. radius from the project. No family is likely to be affected due to this project. The capital cost of the project is Rs.119.02 Crores.

3. The Ministry of Environment and Forests hereby accords environmental clearance as per the provisions of Environmental Impact Assessment Notification 1994 & 2006, subject to strict compliance of the terms and conditions as follows:

Part A: Specific Conditions

- (i) Catchment Area Treatment Plan as has been proposed should be completed in three years. The plan is given below :

- (ii) Forest Clearance to be obtained for acquiring 4.902 hectares forest land & submit it to this Ministry.
- (iii) Consolidation and compilation of the muck should be carried-out in the muck dump sites and the dump sites should be above high flood level.

Part-B: General Conditions


- (i) Adequate free fuel arrangement should be made for the labour force engaged in the construction work at project cost so that indiscriminate felling of trees is prevented.
 - (ii) Fuel depot may be opened at the site to provide the fuel (kerosene/wood/LPG). Medical facilities as well as recreational facilities should also be provided to the labourers.
 - (iii) All the labourers to be engaged for construction works should be thoroughly examined by health personnel and adequately treated before issuing them work permit.
 - (iv) Restoration of construction area including dumping site of excavated materials, should be ensured by filling up of borrow pits, leveling, landscaping etc. The area should be properly treated with suitable plantation.
 - (v) Adequate financial provision should be made in the total budget of the project for implementation of the above suggested safeguard measures.
 - (vi) A Multidisciplinary committee should be constituted with representatives from various disciplines of forestry, ecology, wildlife, soil conservation, NGO etc. to oversee the effective implementation of the suggested safeguard measures.
 - (vii) Six monthly monitoring reports should be submitted to the Ministry and its Regional Office, Bhubaneswar for review.
4. Officials from Regional Office MOEF, Bhubaneswar who would be monitoring the implementation of environmental safeguards should be given full cooperation, facilities and documents/data by the project proponents during their inspection.
5. The responsibility of implementation of environmental safeguards rests fully with the Sileru Power Generation Pvt. Ltd. and Government of Orissa.
6. In case of change in the scope of the project, project would require a fresh appraisal.
7. The Ministry reserves the right to add additional safeguard measures subsequently, if found necessary and to take action including revoking of the clearance under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, to ensure effective implementation of the suggested safeguard measures in a time- bound and satisfactory manner.
8. This clearance letter is valid for a period of five years from the date of issue of this letter for commencement of construction work.

9. A copy of the clearance letter will be marked to concerned Panchayat / local NGO, if any, from whom any suggestion/ representation has been received while processing the proposal.

10 State Pollution Control Board / Committee should display a copy of the clearance letter at the Regional Office, District Industries Center and Collector's office/ Tehsildar's office for 30 days.

11. The project proponent should advertise at least in two local newspapers widely circulated in the region around the project, one of which shall be in the vernacular language of the locality concerned informing that the project has been accorded environmental clearance and copies of clearance letters are available with the State Pollution Control Board / Committee and may also be seen at Website of the Ministry of Environment and Forests at [http:// www.envfor.nic.in](http://www.envfor.nic.in)

CORRIGENDUM

This has reference to the letter no. MOPPL/SPGPL/MoEF/0609/13-14 of Director, Meenakshi Odisha Power Pvt. Ltd. dated 26.8.2013 regarding the validity of environmental clearance (EC) & change of name of the company with regard to the above project. As per Para-8 of the EC of even number dated 23.4.2007, the validity was mentioned as 5 years for commencement of construction work. In this context, the following amendment in para-8 of the EC of even number dated 23.4.2007 is hereby made:

- The environmental clearance is valid for a period of 10 years from the date of issue of this letter (i.e. 23.4.2007) for commissioning of the project.

instead of

- The environmental clearance is valid for a period of 5 years from the date of issue of this letter (i.e. 23.4.2007) for commencement of construction work.
2. The Ministry also considered the change in name of the company and noted that the M/s. Meenakshi Odisha Power Pvt. Ltd. is the Proponent of the project which was hitherto known as M/s. Sileru Power Generation Pvt. Ltd.
 3. All other terms and conditions of the Environmental Clearance Letter No.J-12011/3/2007-IA.I dated 23.4.2007 shall remain unchanged.
 4. Any other conditions if stipulated in future for protection/safeguard of environment would be complied and abided by the Proponent i.e. M/s. Meenakshi Odisha Power Pvt. Ltd.
