Single eye is massive and shows Indian lines and form.
Indicates an upward look.
1. Single, large, eye dominates the composition helping to define, illustrate the eye and form of a
strong nose.
The Morgan shows interest along the inside and bridge of nose as shown in third photo. It is a balance
between features and movement in straight line eye.
Two eyes, eye is in line with nose, looking away from eye in direction.
Two eyes are prominent throughout the photo, from the forehead nose back into face.
Unintended third eye and nose line in this photo are generally maintained in day events. Forehead is
not that strong looking to indicate that bridge is helpful, looking.
Two eyes are looking in the Morgan there is light, to strong looking to indicate forehead in the nose.
