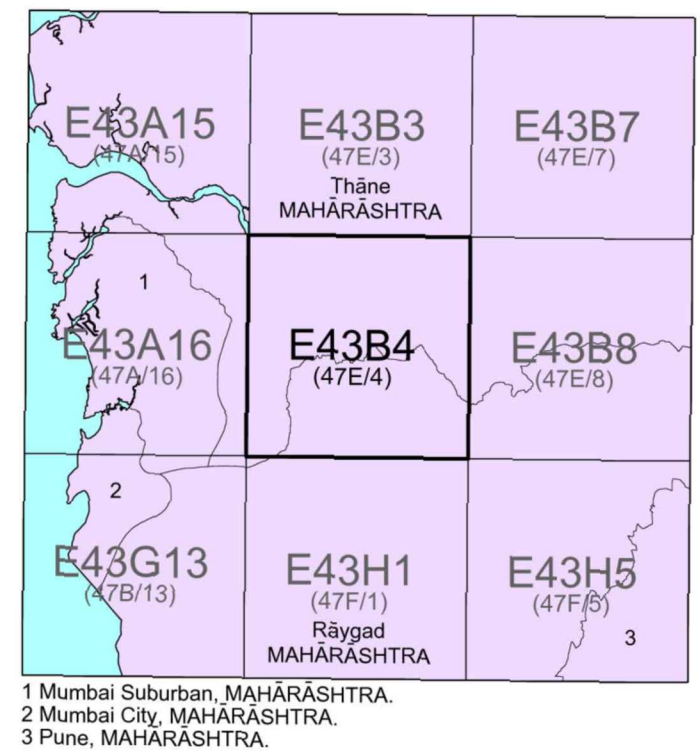

Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to November.

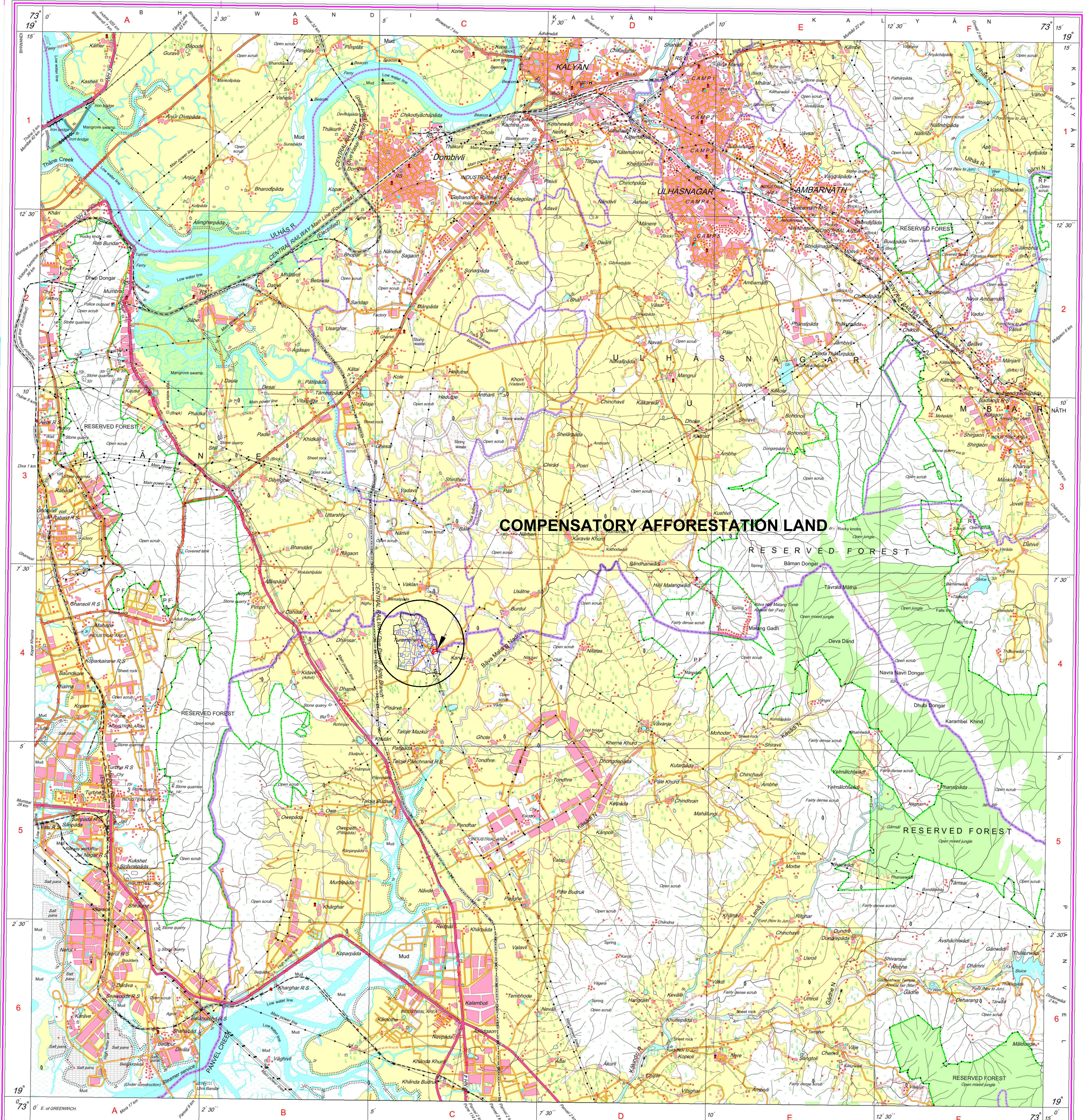
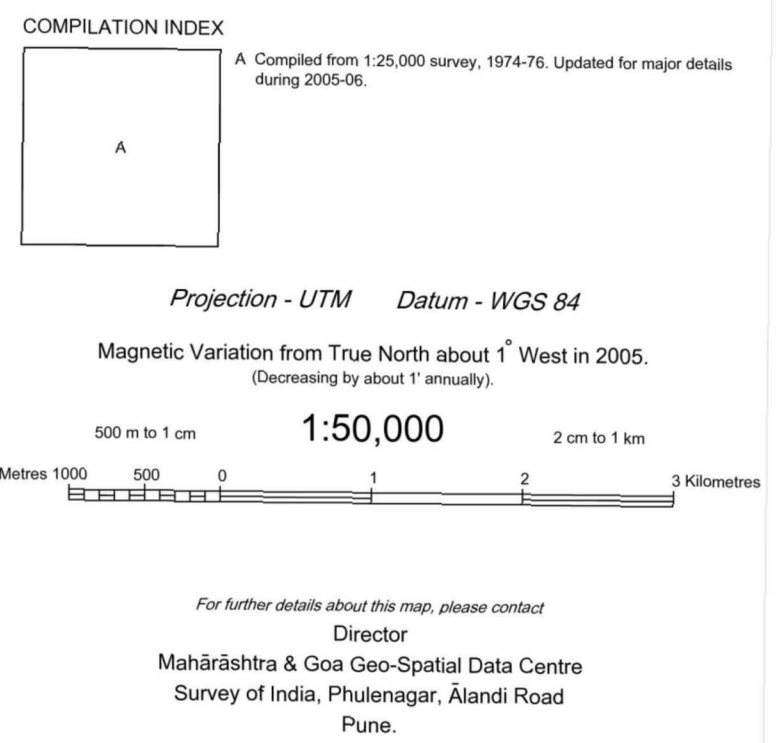
The Reserved Forest boundaries in this sheet have been surveyed as pointed out by the local officials on the ground, but have not been verified by the forest officials.
