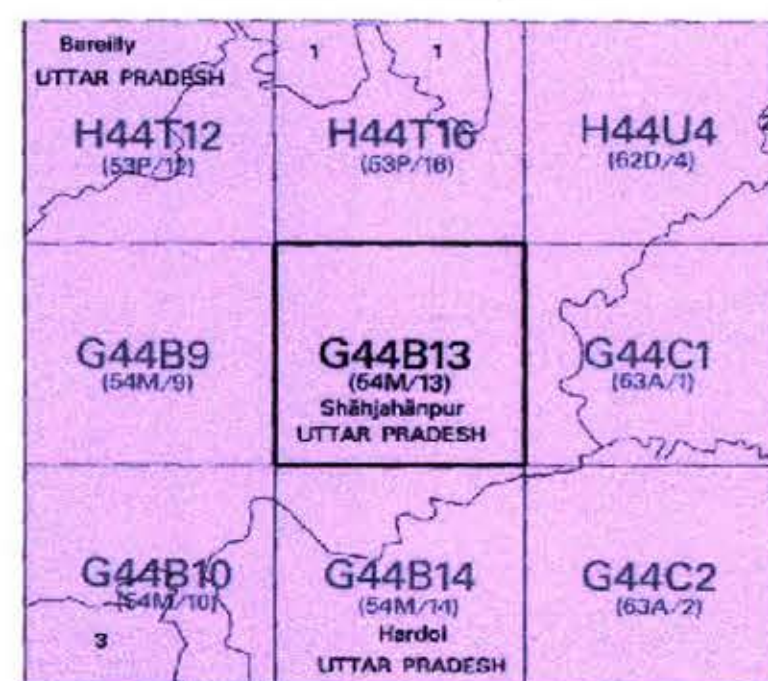

NOTES :-

A relative height scale, expressed in this approximate height, in meters, between the top and bottom of a steep slope (unfettered) and/or at the end of the slope is generally noticeable in dry season. Permission to use these slope scale is required from the irrigation authorities.

Notes, shown only in this view usually contain notes from July to December.

Notes and Tutorials are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been fully shown.

The above scale numbers along slope, railway and roads are shown in slant (e.g., 5' whereas milestone numbers are shown along road, e.g., 5).
