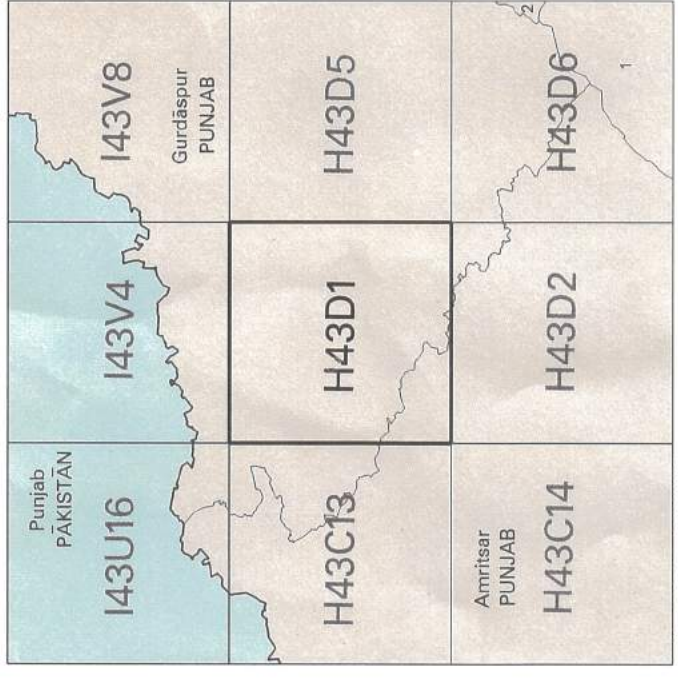

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CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

- Express highway, with toll, with bridge with distance stone

NOTES :-
Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to March.
Tube-wells are numerous throughout the district, only the important ones have been shown.
A relative height, 30', represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
A relative height, e.g., 30', marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.

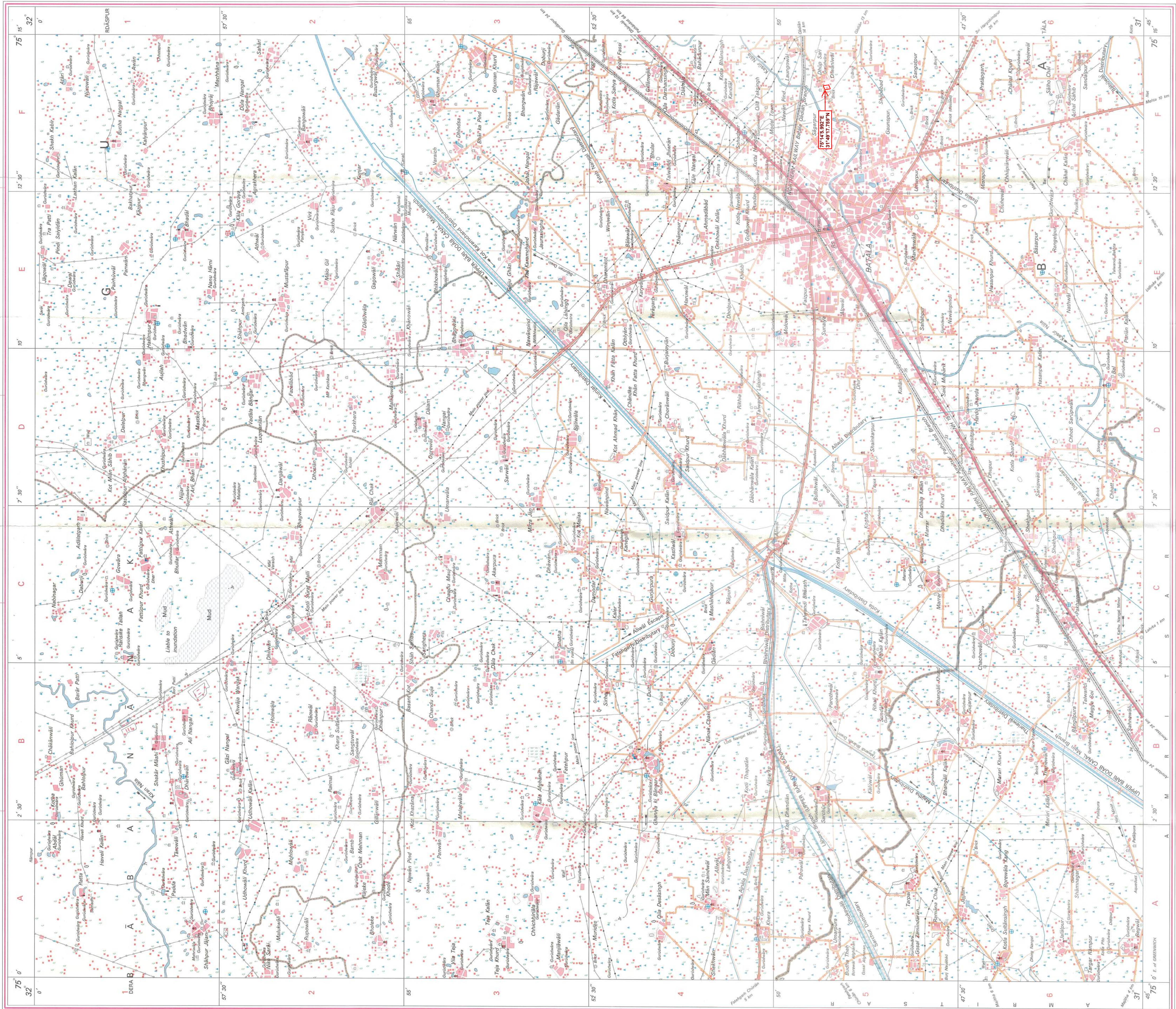
