Water features are shown in blue where they generally contain water.

Coloured areas are coloured yellow.

The exterior boundaries of areas of Reserved or Protected Forests are shown by green chains.

Contours are approximate relative heights, Δh , representing the approximate vertical distance, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

Coloured areas are coloured green, scattered trees are shown in black, and isolated trees in blue, but prominent surveyed trees are in black.

Labels in red indicate areas which have been surveyed by the local officials.

The course of the Ravi River is liable to continual change owing to shifting of the river bed.
