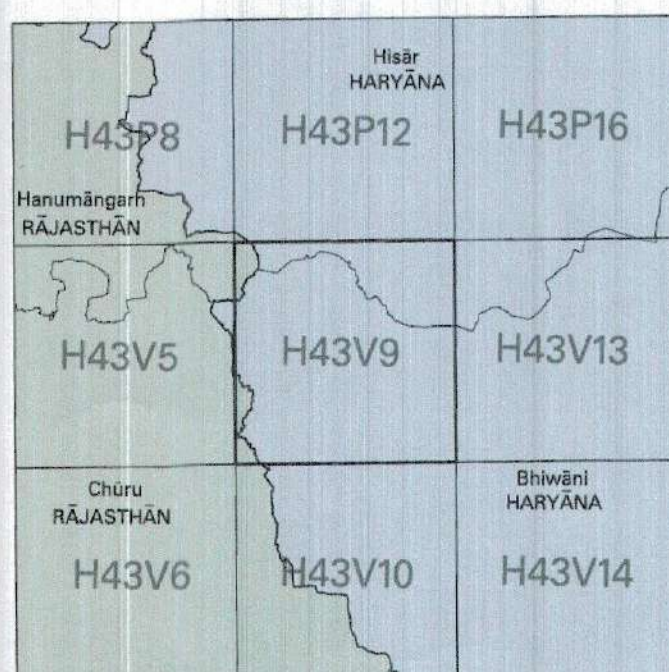

NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.  
Contours are approximate.  
A relative height, e.g., *4r* represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.  
Government buildings are shown in black with numerals.  
A relative height e.g., *20r*, against a wall, in blue, indicates its total depth in metres.  
Tanks, shown dry, in this area, usually contain water from July to December.  
Canal distance stones are 1000 feet apart and every existing fifth stone is shown.  
Undrained well symbols indicate covered tanks, called *Kande* which usually contain surface collection of rain and canal water.  
3,000 acre = reclamation stones of Bhakra Dam Project Surveys and with their numbers are shown
