Ltd., Bhubbaneswar. DGPS survey co-ordinates are verified by ORSAC. Also maps showing forest areas proposed for diversion are verified with geo-referenced cadastral sheet/surveyed points (for R.F. areas) and compared with Ortho-rectified Cattorat Satellite image and found that maps are correct at a confidence level of 595%. All the forest areas proposed for diversion comes in one Cadastral sheet of village Bonda and two patches in Benamunda R.F. Total forest area proposed for diversion works out to 2.119 Ha. Includes 0.367 Ha. Revenue forest area and 1.752 Ha. R.F. area from the submitted .shp files against the allotted area of 0.367 Ha. Revenue forest area as mentioned in the submitted land schedule.
