TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance OF THE Ministry of Environment and forest (MoEF), Government of India's letter E No.11/9/98-FC (Pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non forest purposes, it is certified that 0.069 Hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Assam Power Generation Corporation Limited (APGCL) for construction of an intake well in Joypur Reserve Forest under Dibrugarh Division, Dibrugarh district, falls within jurisdiction of NIL Village (s) in NIL Tehsils.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 0.069 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion. Copy of DFO Dibrugarh's letter No. GC/87/2015/1618 Dated 19.03.2015 & a copy of Project Director, I.T.D.P, Dibrugarh's Letter No. DSTP.36/DLFR/2012/94 (pt-II)/555 Dated Dibrugarh the 18th May' 2015 under whom the proposed location of Intake Well falls, stating that there exists no human habitation, forest villagers in the locality, are enclosed as Annexure-A and Annexure-B respectively. Moreover, Circular No. FRS/55/2012/100 Dated Dispur the 12th February' 2014 from The Chief Secretary to the Government of Assam certified that no non forest government land is available in the state of Assam for undertaking Compensatory Afforestation is enclosed as Annexure-C.
- (b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concern Gram Sabha of forest dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA: **Does no arise, in view of sl no. (a) above.**
- (c) The each concern Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the Gram Sabha of NIL Village(s) is enclosed: **Does not arise, in view of sl no. (a) above.**
- (d) The discussion and decision on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present: **Does not arise, in view of sl no. (a) above.**
- (e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and Gram Sabhas have given their concent to it: **Does not arise, in view of sl no. (a) above.**
- (f) Rights of primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where application have been specially safe guarded as per section 3(1) (e) of FRA: **Does not arise, in view of sl no. (a) above.**




