

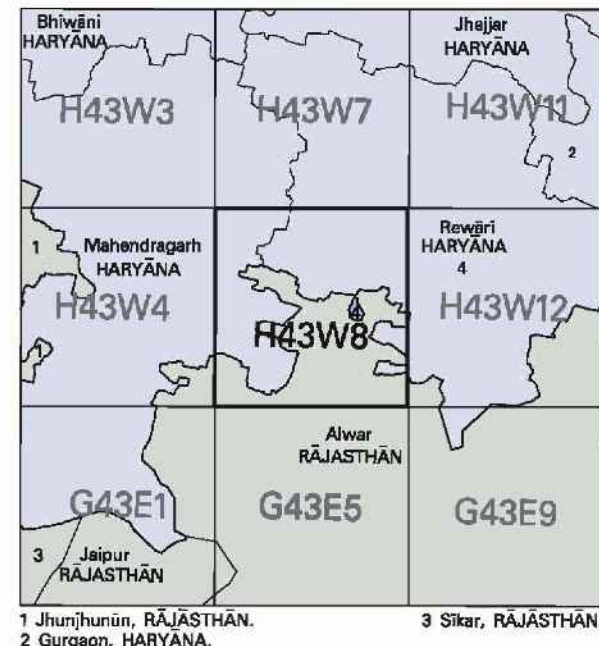

The contours in this sheet have been shown at 10 metres vertical interval in places up to 300 metres and 20 metres vertical interval in places above 300 metres.
1:50,000 - some intermediate contour of 100m from project survey are shown as tertiary bench mark from 1:25,000.
