

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MOEF) Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines and submission of the evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 23th May 2017 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 3.439 Hectares of Forest Land proposed to be diverted in favour of RURAL DEVELOPMENT & PANCHAYAT RAJ DEPARTMENT for the formation of new road from **Muniranvattam Village to Necknamalai Village**, Tirupattur Range and Ambur Range It is certified that:

(a) Certified that the proposal has been examined with reference to ensuring compliance of scheduled tribes and other traditional forest dwellers(Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006.

(b) Certified that there are No Scheduled tribes and other traditional Forest Dwellers in the above villages and consequently no claims have been received under this Act with respect to the area proposed for the diversion of forest land for the formation of new road from Muniranvattam village to Necknamalai Village the project area proposed for forest land.

(c) The proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural communities, in the Muniranvattam & Necknamalai Village(s) of Alangayam Panchayat Union Tirupattur Range and Ambur Range, Tirupattur District. So the recognized rights of PTG and PAC are not affected.
