

A. General Details:

iii) Short narrative of the proposal and project for which forest land is required:

The proposed location URAA falls in Golaghat dist. PEL of Golaghat district with objectives to explore hydrocarbon from Bokabil & Barail formations. The location is situated at the downthrown side of a major NE-SW trending normal fault. The well UR-2 has been an oil producer in Bokabil Formation from adjoining field Uriamghat. Prospect URAA is strategically positioned to target the downthrown areas of the NE-SW trending fault which is envisaged to open up unexplored but prospective areas towards eastern part of the basin. The prospect URAA is also situated at a structurally up dip fault closure at Barail Unconformity level which is favourable for hydrocarbon entrapment. So the location is envisaged to fulfill both the objectives with anticipated IOIP of 4.03MMt. The area is highly prospective with proven hydrocarbons in nearby fields. In the view of adding to the economic growth of the country prospect URAA proposed for Forest clearance in this area.

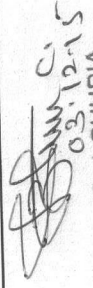
ix) Total period for which forest land is diverted: 2-3 years

D. Justification for locating the project in Forest land:

The location URAA is proposed in a structurally favourable position in the subsurface and surface location fall in the forest land. Detail G&G studies including log correlation, amplitude analysis, coherency studies, mapping etc. have been carried out and good reservoir facies for hydrocarbon accumulation is expected to be encountered at the proposed location URAA. Structural disposition also indicate good entrapment condition for hydrocarbon.
