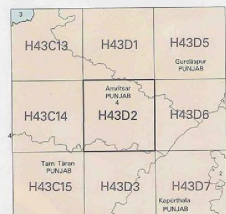

NOTES :-

Canal distance shows a 1000 feet apart and every entering 500 yards is shown.
Trunks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to March.
Tide-galls are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
A relative height, $\pm$, represents the approximate height, in contrast, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Fertilization to the far, corrects and uncorrected roads along canals is required from the irrigation authority.
A relative height, $\pm$, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
The administrative boundaries and names have been brought up-to-date to 2007.

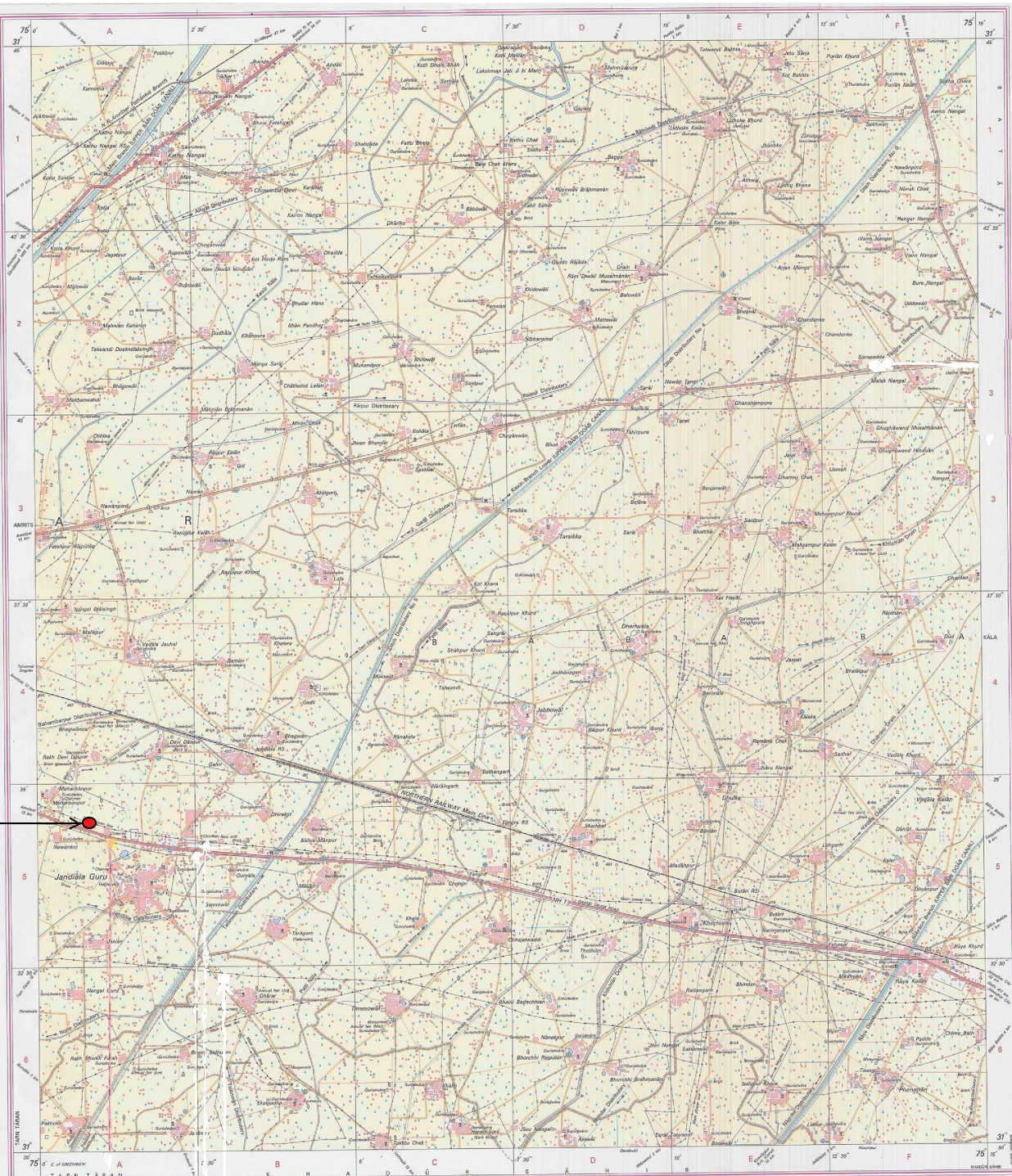
