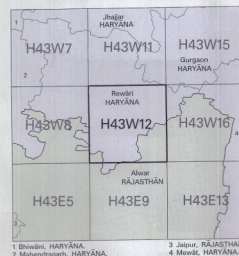

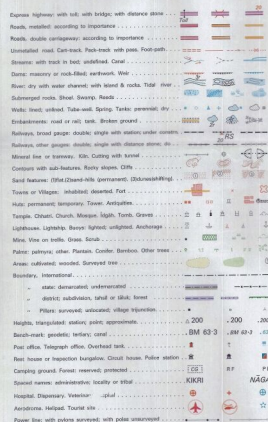

Tanks, down dry, in this area usually contain water from July to March.
Tube wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
Unimproved roads and cart-roads in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use such along canals is required from the Irrigation authorities.

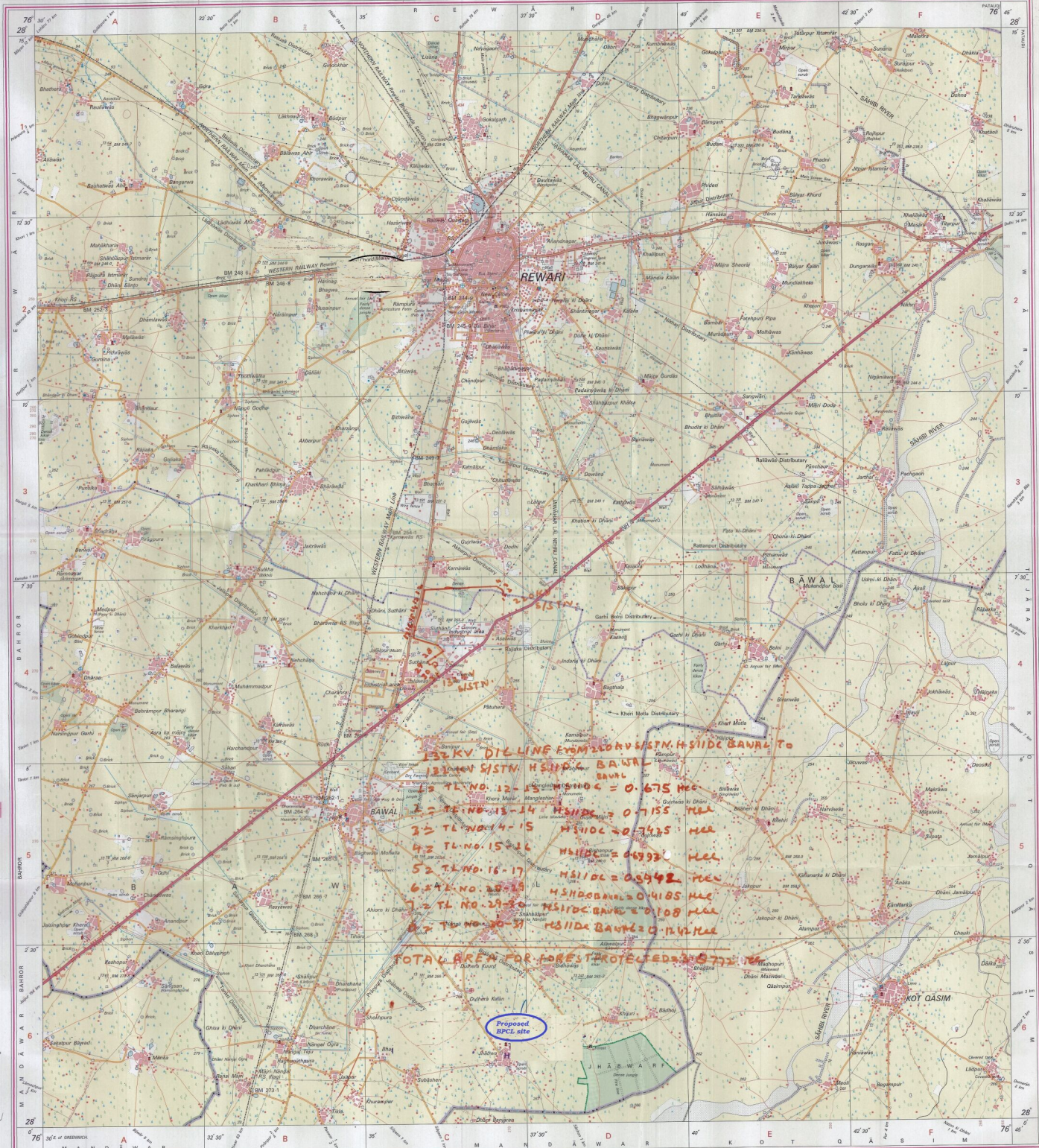
