TO WHOM SO EVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC(pt) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that **0.0995 hectares** of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of **M/s Commissioner of Police, Cyberabad Commissionerate, Telangana State for the proposal "Construction of APCO 25 tower for phase II Network in Mazeedpur village of Lalgadimalakpet RF in Medchal-Malkajgiri District"** falls within jurisdiction of Mazeedpur village, Shamirpet tehsils.

It is further certified that :

- a. The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 0.0995 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee (s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Divisional Level Committee(s) and the District level Committee are enclosed as annexure.... to annexure....
- b. The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before concerned Gram Sabha of forest-Dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA.
- c. The each concerned Gram Sabha(s) has certified that all formalities/processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the Gram Sabha of **Mazeedpur village** is enclosed as annexure.... to annexure....
- d. The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present;
- e. The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabhas have given their consent to it;
- f. The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3 (1)(e) of the FRA.

The Commissioner of Police, Cyberabad Commissionerate, Telangana State has requested to issue a resolution in respect of the proposals submitted for diversion of **0.0995 Ha** of forest land in Lalgadimalakpet RF of Medchal Division for Construction of APCO 25 Tower for phase II Network in Greater Hyderabad Police Commissionerates in Medchal-Malkajgiri District.

Accordingly the Gram Sabha of Mazeedpur village Gram Panchayath has passed a resolution stating that there is no objection for diversion of proposed forest land in favour of Commissioner of Police, Cyberabad Commissionerate, Telangana State as there is no encroachments by the tribal people in the proposed forest land to be diverted and further resolved that there are no pending RoFR claims to be settled under the forest Rights Act.

A Divisional Committee meeting was also held on 10.6.2020 under the Chairmanship of the Revenue Divisional officer, Keesera Division.

Basing on the resolution passed by the Gram Sabha, the members of Sub-Divisional Level Committee, Medchal-Malkajgiri District have no objection regarding the diversion of forest land measuring an extent of 0.0995 Ha in Mazeedpur village for Construction of APCO 25 Tower for phase II Network at Mazeedpur at Sy. No. 129 in Shamirpet Mandal of Medchal-Malkajgiri District in favour of Commissioner of Police, Cyberabad Commissionerate, Telangana State and subsequent issue of Certificate in Form-I.

In view of the above, the District level Committee meeting was conducted on 11.06.2020 and passed the resolution for submitting the Form-II proposals for other than linear projects. No objections are raised during the meeting.
