The Grama Sabhas came to the conclusion that the Airport Authority of India, Kadapa YSR District has proposed for *Diversion of forest land erecting obstacle light mast for aviation purpose in favour of Director, Airports Authority of India, Kadapa YSR District*

to an extent of **0.02 Ha** in which there are no scheduled tribes or Pre-Agricultural Community people. No area is under the cultivation of scheduled tribes or scheduled community and also no community rights were given to the villagers. Hence the issue of developmental works in above Forest Compartment is considered to allow for "Diversion of forest land erecting obstacle light mast for aviation purpose" in the above area.

- 2). In accordance with forest rights act 2006, the Grama Sabhas in majority had discussed in detail and had came to a conclusion that there are no individual claims or community claims are affected in the said area. Hence approval may be granted to the *Diversion of forest land erecting* obstacle light mast for aviation
 - (1). For 0.01 Ha in Reserved Forest area Compt.No.76, Chennamukkalapalle RF, Bayanapalli Beat, Proddatur Range of Proddatur Wildlife Division. (and)
 - (2). For 0.01 Ha in Reserved Forest Compartment No.80, Lankamala RF, Balasingapalli Beat, Proddatur Range of Proddatur Wildlife Division in favour of Director, Airports Authority of India, Kadapa YSR District, to an extent of 0.01 + 0.01 = 0.02 Ha (0.04942 Acres) and Grama Sabhas do not have any objections.
- 3). The Forest Range Officer, Proddatur was stated that above forest compartment have been inspected and these land are not under cultivation of Scheduled Tribes or Scheduled Community and no community rights were given to the villagers on behalf of Transport Department may be allowed to Diversion of forest land for Erecting obstacle light mast for aviation in Compartment No.76 of Chennamukkalapalle RF, Bayanapalli Beat, Proddatur Wildlife Division (and) Compartment No.80, Lankamala R.F., Balasingapalli Beat, Proddatur Range of Proddatur Wildlife Division in favour of the Director, Airports Authority of India, Kadapa YSR District in the above forest area.
