

Justification

Subject : Renewal of 0.80 Ha Forest land in F. Sy. No. 108 A1 of Kodibag Village, Karwar Taluk, Uttar Kannada District in favour of Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute Cochin for construction of office cum laboratory building.

Karwar Regional Station of ICAR-CMFRI is a pioneer organisation conducting marine aquaculture related research activities such as finfish seed production and farming. The station has established a marine hatchery complex at Kodibag village, Karwar Taluk, Uttar kannada District for conducting research activities related to marine finfish breeding and seed production. The marine hatchery complex is acting as a nodal centre for imparting training programmes and extension activities for expanding marine fish farming through out the country. It also carries out research activities leading to breeding and seed production of new candidate fishes for the benefit of fish farmers. The marine hatchery complex has been established in the 0.8 Ha Forest land in F. Sy. No. 108 A1 of Kodibag Village, Karwar Taluk, Uttar Kannada District. Presently, the lease period of 0.8 Ha Forest land need to be renewed for continuing the activities of the station.

The marine hatchery complex of Karwar RS of ICAR-CMFRI is highly essential for conducting important research activities in the marine aquaculture field for enhancing the finfish production of the country through research and extension activities. The hatchery is acting as a major source for supply of marine fish seed in Karnataka state. Hence, it is requested to renew the 0.80 Ha Forest land in F. Sy. No. 108 A1 of Kodibag Village, Karwar Taluk, Uttar Kannada District .
