In compliance of the ministry of Environment and forests (MoEF), Government of India, letter No. 11-9/98- FC (Pt.) Dated 3rd August 2009 where in the MoEF issued guide lines on submission of evidences of having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional and Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act 2006, ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter Dated 5th February 2013 where in MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 1.37 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Executive Engineer, Panchayat Raj (PIU) Division, Visakhapatnam (Name of the user Agency) for "Formation and BT to the Road including construction of culverts from Jerrila to Panasapalli" (purpose for diversion of forest land) in Visakhapatnam District falls within jurisdiction of Jerrila & Panasapalli villages in G.K. (c) The proposal does not involve recognized right of primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities.
