In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidence for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013, 5th July 2013 and 15th Jan 2014 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that **3.81 Hectare** of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of **Public Health & Engineering Department** (Name of User Agency) for laying of **Pipe Line** (Purpose for diversion of forest land) Borav forest Range and Chittorgarh forest division of Chittorgarh District falls within jurisdiction of Gram Panchayat **Bhesrodgarh, Shripura, Dhangarmaukalan, Borav, Gopalpura, Tambolai** villages **Jagpura, Kodiakhal, Bhesrodgarh, Gopalpura, Unser. Aamba, Bh.Peermagra, Shripura, Khelgaon, Unser. Nasera, Dhangarmaukhurd, Umarcha, Nagpura, Borav and Nahargarh** (Forest Compartment Distt. Chittorgarh Total AARAJI No. 51 area **3.81 Hectare**) Rawatbhata tehsils, Chittorgarh District.

It is further certified that:

- a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire total **3.81 Hectare** of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s); Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as Annexure 1,2 & 3 respectively.
- b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest-dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA,
- c) the each of concerned Gram Sabha (s), has certified that all formalities / processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion, A copy of certificate issued by the Gram Sabha of Bhesrodgarh, Shripura, Dhangarmaukalan, Borav, Tambolia village is enclosed as annexure 1.
- d) the discussion and decision on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50 % of the Gram Sabha present.
- e) the diversion of Forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and Gram Sabha have given their consent to it ;
- f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3 (1) (e) of the FRA.
