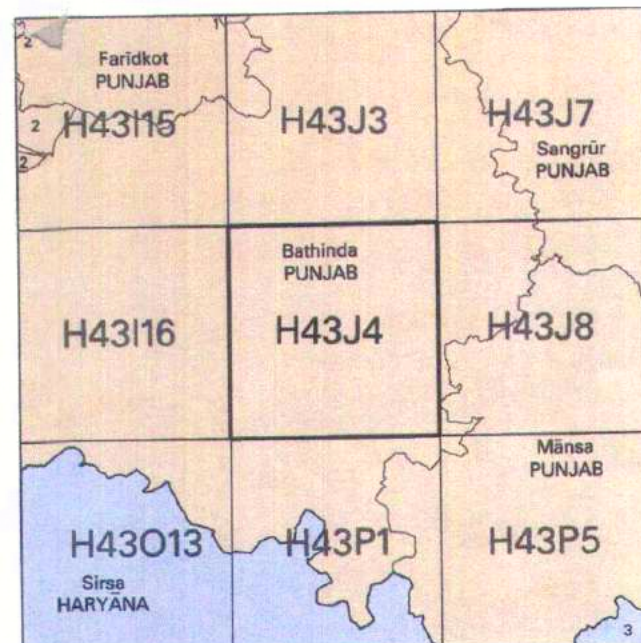

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CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

- Express highway with toll; with bridge; with distance stone
- Roads, metalled, according to importance
- Roads, double cartway, according to importance
- Unmetalled road, Cart-track, Pack-track with pass, Foot-path
- Stretches with track in bed, undefined, Canal
- Ditch, masonry or rock-filled, earthen, Weir
- River, dry with water channel, with island & rocks, Tidal river
- Submerged rocks, Shoal, Swamp, Flood
- Wells: lined, unlined, Tube-well, Spring, Tanks: perennial, dry
- Embankments: road or rail; tank, Broken ground
- Railways, broad gauge: double, single with station; under constr.
- Railways, other gauges: double, single with distance stone; do.
- Mineral line or tramway, Kilm, Cutting with tunnel
- Contours with sub-features, Rocky slopes, Cliffs

- Mine, View on tress, Grass, Scrub
- Palms; palmiers, other, Plantain, Cactus, Bamboo, Other trees
- Areas: cultivated, wooded, Surveyed tree
- Boundary, international
- state, demarcated, undemarcated
- district, subdivision, taluk or taluk, forest
- Boundary pillars: surveyed, unlocated, village junction
- Heights, triangulated, station, point, approximate
- Bench-mark: geodetic, tertiary, canal
- Post office, Telegraph office, Overhead tank
- Rest house or reception bungalow, Circuit house, Police station
- Camping ground, Forest: reserved, protected
- Spaced names: administrative, locality or tribal
- Hospital, Dispensary, Veterinary hospital
- Aerodrome, Heliport, Tourist site
- Power line: with pylons surveyed, with poles unsurveyed

NOTES :-

A relative height, 'R', represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Permission to use cart-tracks and unmetalled roads along canals and protective embankments is required from the irrigation authorities.
Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to January.
Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
A relative height e.g. '4', marked along a canal indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country, whereas that along drain represents the height of the top of the embankment from bottom of the drain.
Distance stones along canals and protective embankment are 1,000 feet apart and every existing fifth stone is shown, except along Ghuman Distributary, Talwandi Distributary and Kotta Branch (SIRHIND CANAL) where these are 5,000 feet apart and every existing one is shown.
Most of the unlined wall symbols indicate covered tank, called funds, which usually contain surface collection of rainwater.

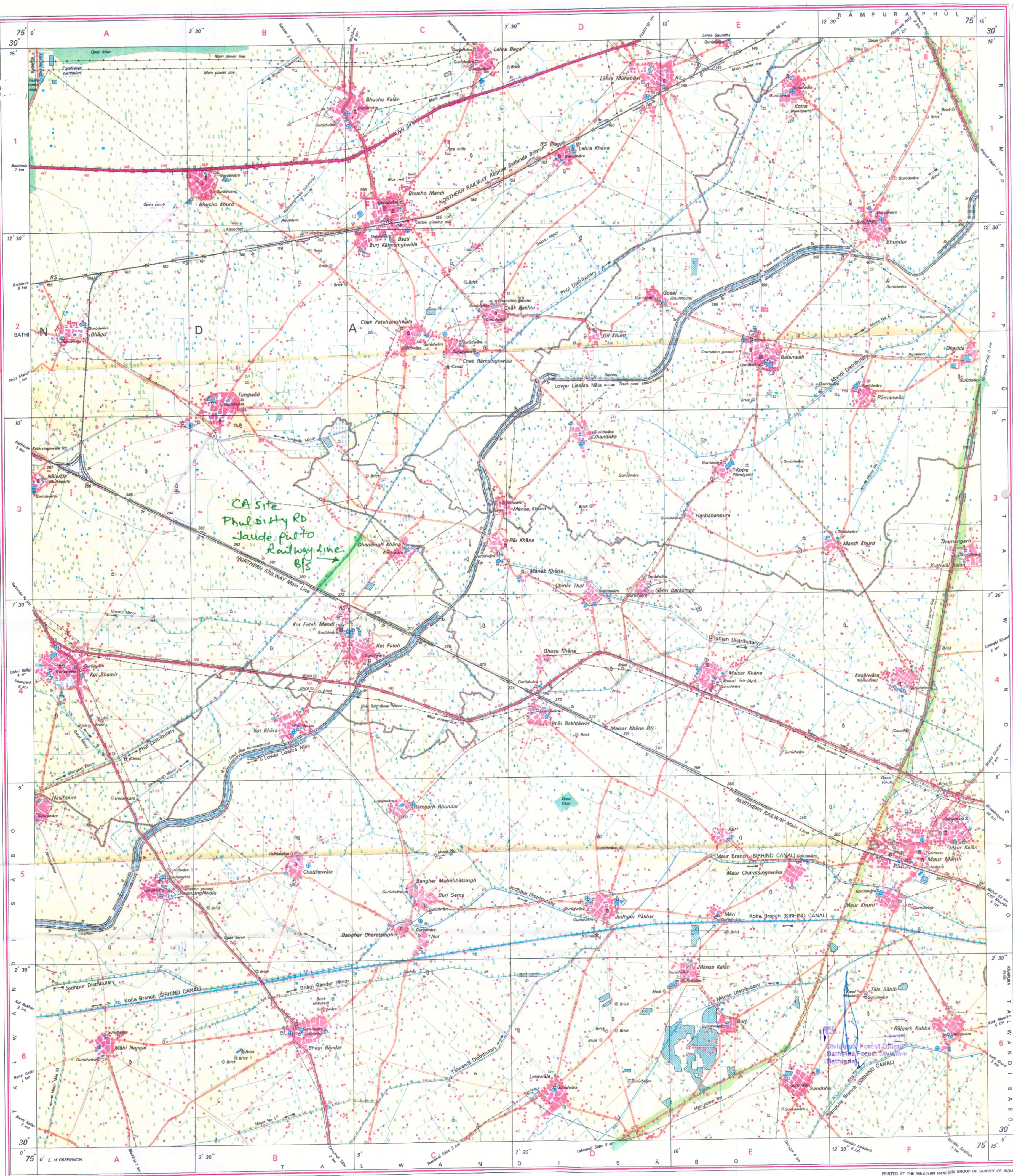
