
TO WHOMSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Rule 6(3)(e) of the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003 [as amended vide the Forest [Conservation] Amendment Rule 2014; Forest (Conservation) Second Amendment Rule 2014; and Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2016] it is certified that 0.146 Hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of the Executive Engineer, PWD/WRD Lower Pennaiyar Basin Division Villupuram District for Reconstruction of dilapidated head sluice, bed dam, retaining wall and culvert in Malattar Channel for supplying water to Thiruvannainallur Taluk tanks of Villupuram District falls within jurisdiction of Thiruvannainallur Taluk.

It is further Certified that

- a) The complete process of recognition and vesting of forest right under the FRA, 2006 has been carried out for the 0.146 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion. A Copy of records all consultation and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee (S) Gram sabha (S), Sub Division level Committee(S) and the District level Committee are enclosed as attachment : No individual or community rights claim have been received in the area proposed to diversion.
- b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implication, in vernacular/ local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram sabha or forest- dwellers, who are eligible under the Forest Rights Act, 2006 : Not applicable as no claim under Forest Rights Act, 2006, have been received for the area proposed for diversion.

- c) Each of concerned Gram Sabha (s) has certified that all formalities process under the Forest Rights Act have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion : Not applicable as there are no claims under Forest Rights Act 2006 pertaining to the area proposed to permission.
- d) The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha : Not applicable as no claims were received under Forest Rights Act 2006.
- e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the Forest Rights Act have been completed and the Gram Sabha have given their consent to it : Not applicable as there are no claims under Forest Rights Act 2006 pertaining to the area proposed.
- f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3 (1) (e) of the Forest Rights Act, 2006.
