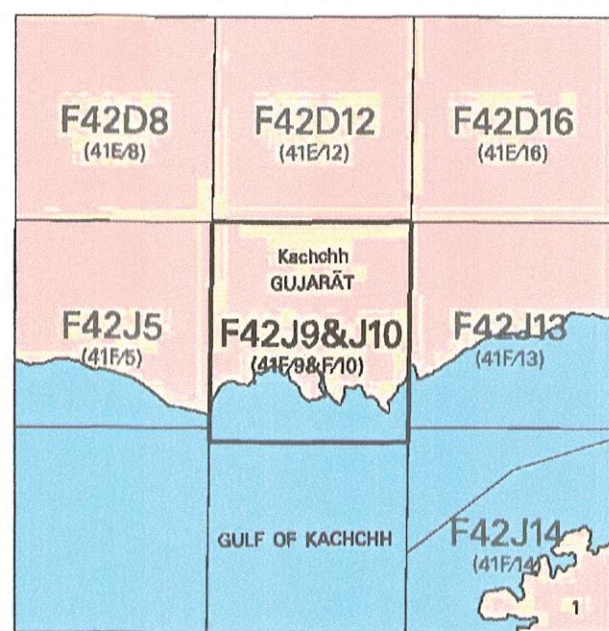

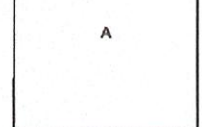
Tanks shown dry in this area usually contain water from July to October.

Unaided wells are mostly dry in this sheet.

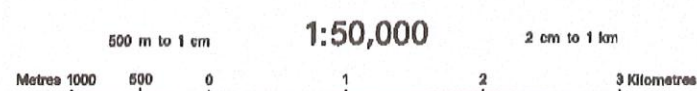

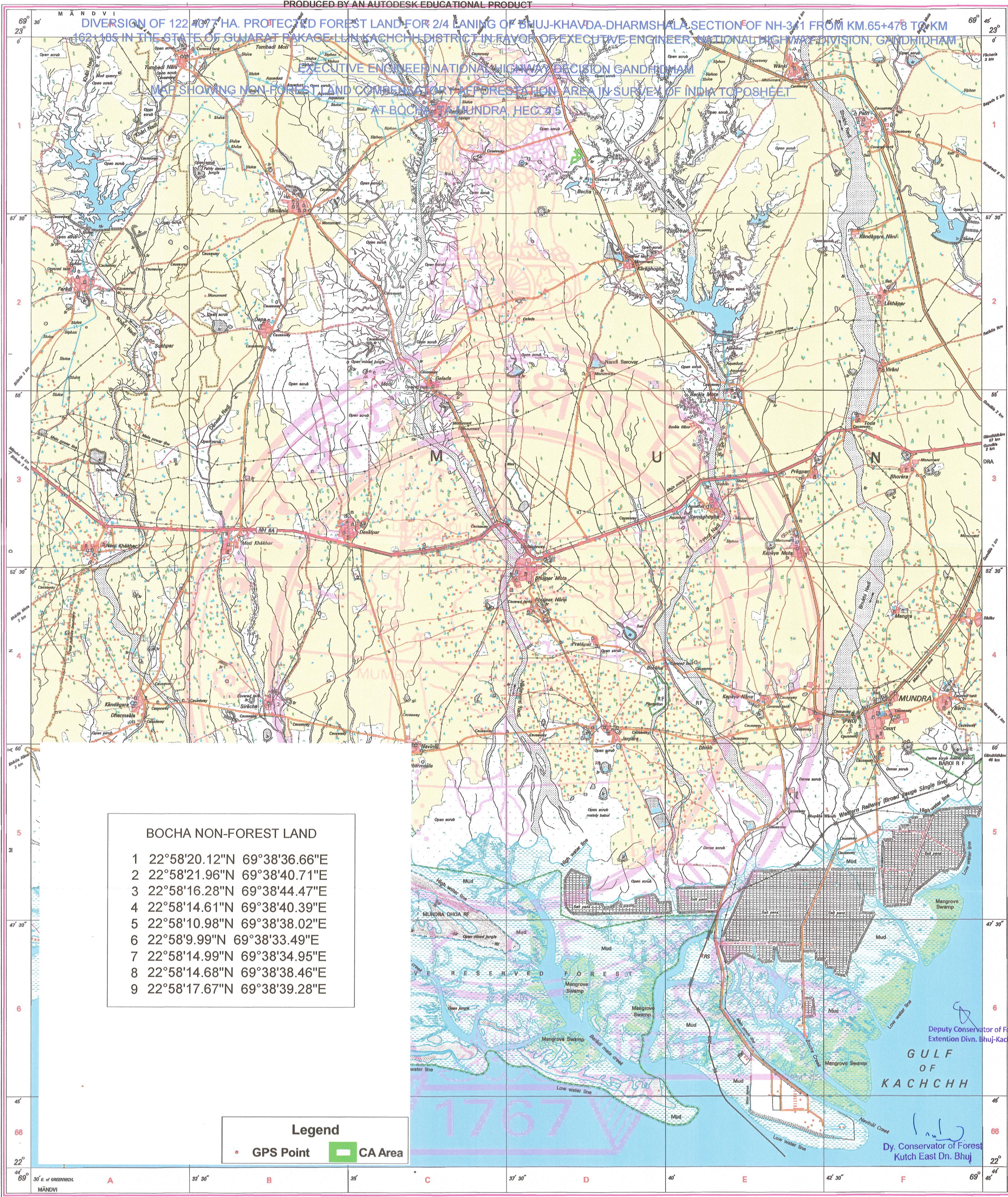
