To WHOM SO EVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted in for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 0.687 hectares of forest land and 4.253 hectares revenue forest land i.e: 4.94 hectares to be diverted in favour of Executive Engineer, Chhattisgarh State Power Transmission Company Ltd. (CSPTCL) for Satpata (Bishrampur) to Kaushalpur (Ramanujnagar) Transmission line in Surajpur district falls within Jurisdiction of Salka, Pondi, Jobga, Ketka, Amagaon, Patna, Chandrikapur, Rampur, Dawna, Saraipara and Ramanujnagar villages in Surajpur and Ramanujnagar tehsil.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 4.94 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the forest rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub division level committee(s) are enclosed as annexure 01 to annexure 171.
- (b) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA has been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it.
- (c) The proposal does not involve recognised rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural Communities.
