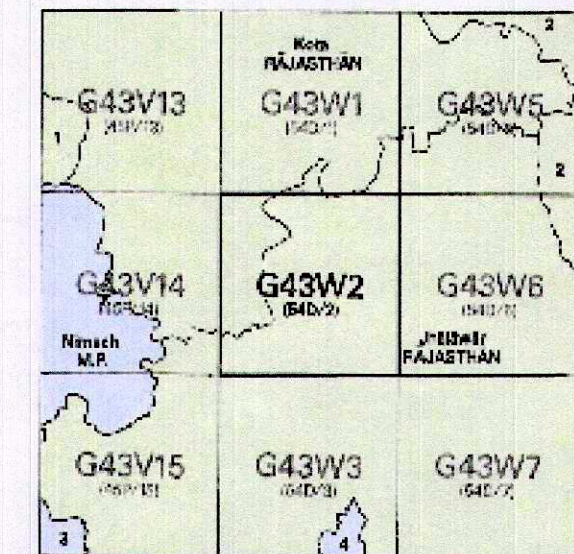


LAYOUT PLAN OF PROPOSED JHALRAPATAN RAILWAY STATION FROM CH- 0 TO 730 M.

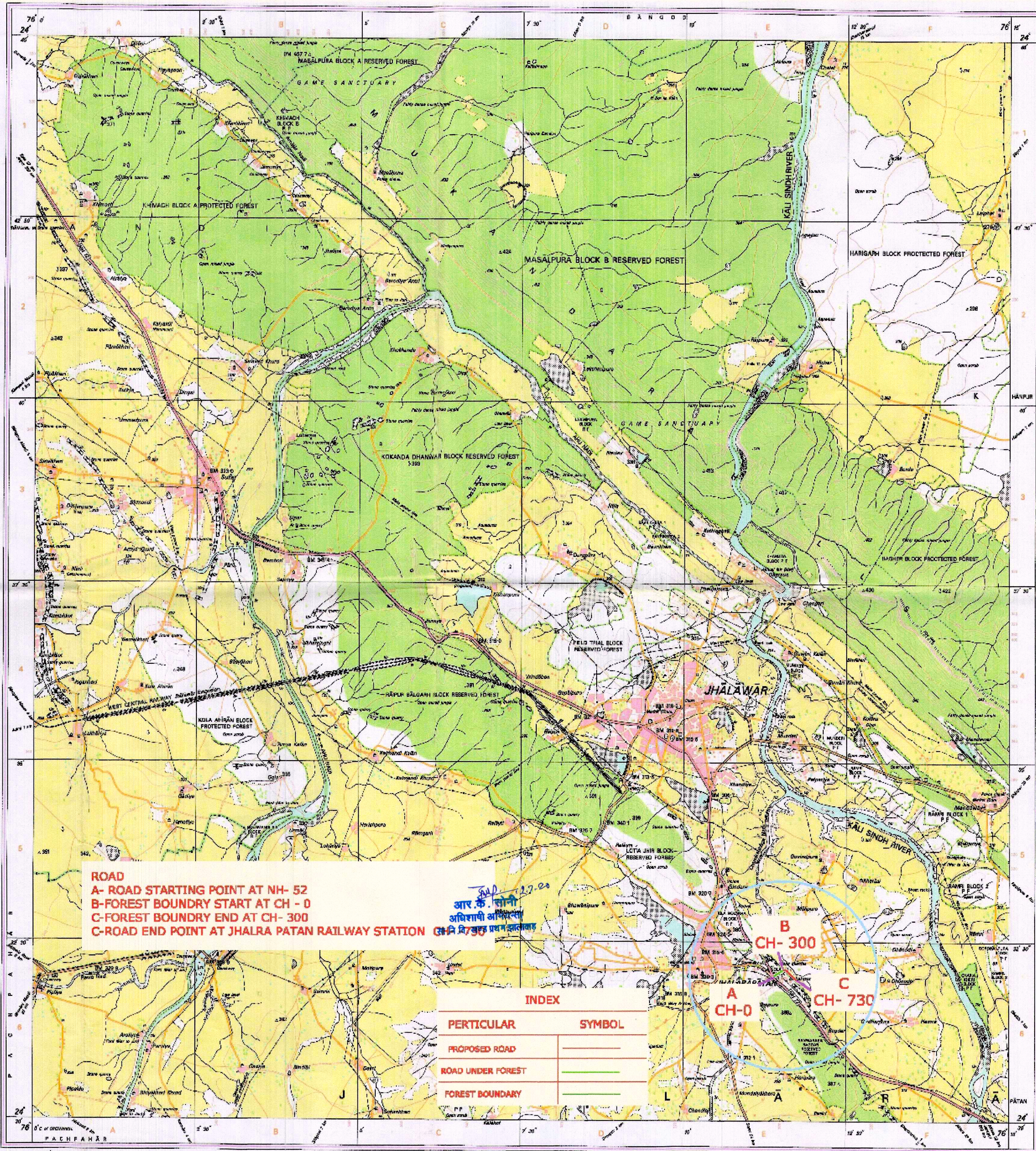
