

### BRIEF NOTE

Widening the existing BT road including formation of road in the widened portion and laying of Plastic BT road from Vishwakarma Colony to Bachupally road through forest land in Ward No.129-Suraram, Gajularamaram Circle, GHMC

The existing road is running on the embankment and at higher level than the existing ground level. The width of the road is only 3.6 mtrs and damaged at several locations due to erosion of the side berms which is of less than 1 mtr. It is a busy road connecting from Bachupally road to Vishwakarma Colony and much difficulty is being faced when heavy vehicles come in both directions at a time.

In view of the above, it is essential to repair the existing BT road, its side berms, widening of the road along with formation & to lay BT road. The said road passes through forest land and proposals were submitted to the forest department to give clearance for widening the road. If this road is not there the public have to travel about 8 Km extra to reach Bachupally against 1.5 Kms if the road through forest land is used.

The length of the road passing through Reserve Forest area as per the DGPS authentication received from PCCF office is 1423.62 M.

The existing road with width of 4.0 M is proposed for widening to a width of 3.0 M, hence the total width of the road 7.0 M is taken into consideration for calculating the forest area required for diversion.

$$1423.62 \text{ MX } 7.0 \text{ M} = 9965.34 \text{ Sq.Mts} = 0.996 \text{ Ha.}$$

As there is no alternative to that of widening of the existing double lane road, proposal is being furnished for diversion of forest land.



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
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
