
In inviting a kind reference to the subject cited above, as per your instruction, suitable patches of 106.232Ha, 65.68Ha, 26.52Ha in village Duipani and Dudipani of non-forest Govt. land & revenue forest land has been successfully identified in Pallahara Tahsil of Deogarh Forest Division which comprises plantation of 80,000 no of plants.

However, as per the MoEF & CC Guideline No F. No. 11-423/2011-FC Dated 08.11.2017, if the requisite no of plants @1000/ha cannot be planted on the identified non-forest land for taking up CA, then the balance no of plants will be planted in the degraded forest land as per the provisions of the working plans.

Accordingly, 100.07Ha, 20.67 Ha, 70.22Ha of degraded forest land has been identified in Kakharua PRF, Atanaka PRF and Ranjo PRF respectively in Pallahara Range of this division for plantation of balance 76,000/- number of trees.
