



 A relative height, 'dr', represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
 Tanks, shown dry, in this area, usually contain water from July to December.
 Blue-wells are numerous throughout the sheet; only the important ones have been shown.
 The kilometre numbers along roads, railway and canals are shown in short type, e.g. '5' whereas distances numbers are shown in upright type e.g. '5.2'.
 Inmetalled roads and cart-tracks in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use these along canals is required from the Irrigation authorities.
 Important buildings are shown in black.
