

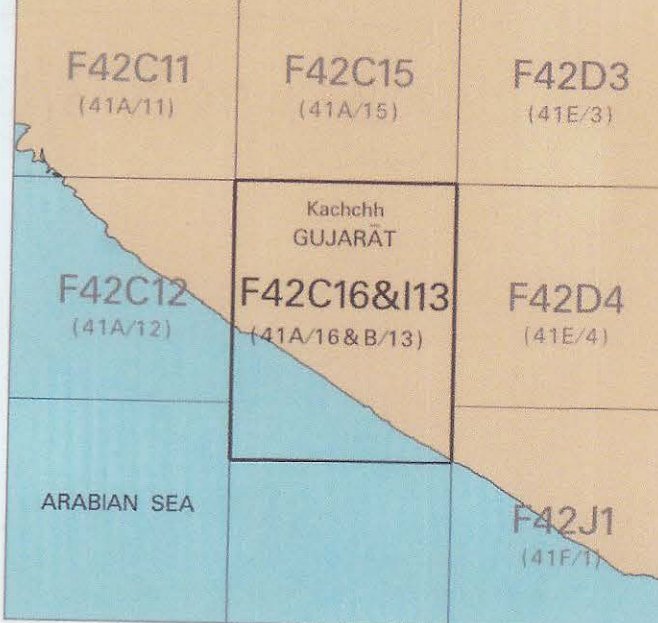

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CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

- Express Highway: with toll with bridge; with distance stone
- Roads, metalled: according to importance
- Double carriageway: according to importance
- Unmetalled Road: Cart-track, Push-track and pass, Foot-path
- Streams: with track in bed, unfordable, Canal
- Dam: masonry or rock shell, earthen dam, Tidal river
- River: dry with water channel; with island & rocks, Tidal river
- Submerged rocks, Shoal, Swamp, Reefs
- Wells: hand, unfired, Tube-well, Spring, Tank: perennial, dry
- Embarkments: road or rail, tanks, Broken ground
- Railways, broad gauge: double, single with station; under construction

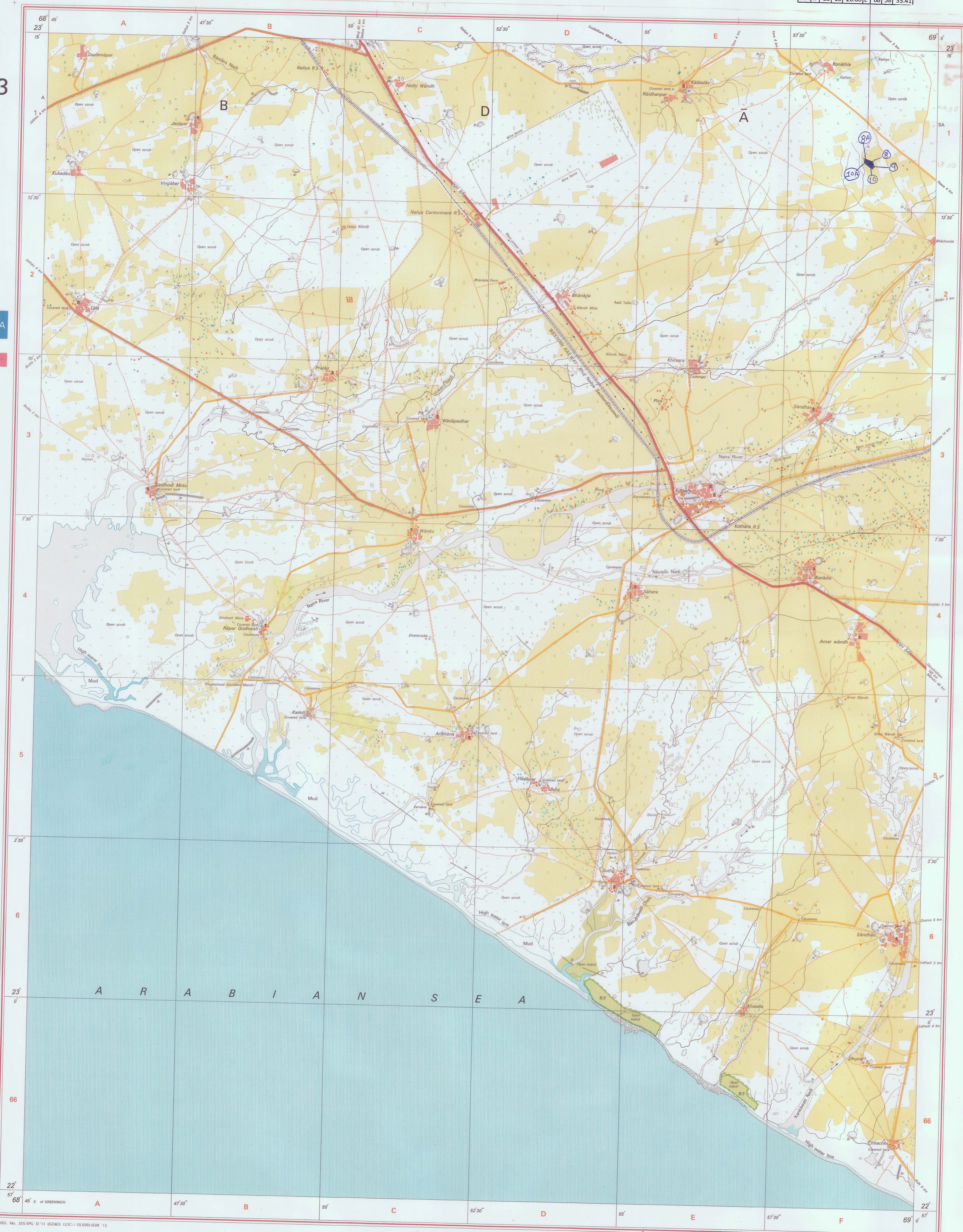
