



 The kilometre stone numbers along roads, railways and canals are shown in short type, e.g. '5' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type e.g. '5'.
 Unmetalled roads and cart- tracks in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use these along canals is required from the irrigation authorities.
 Important buildings are shown in black.
